DID YOU KNOW? : **WEEKLY ATTENDANCE** is now available check out the new **System Dashboard** for latest news on the DUES Members.

Welcome to the District And Club database (DACdb), which contains member, club, committee, and district database. Thus, it is the master database for the district information and can be updated by individual members, District Chairs, Club Officers (e.g. Club Presidents & Secretaries), and District Administrators (once they are assigned the proper security level). This is a district-level database, however recent developments have made IT suitable to replace your club's recordkeeping systems, such as ClubMate/RI-CAS. And, there are many "reports" available to the clubs as a by-product of this database (such as a current **Member Roster** and **Club Directory** with Member Photos, an itemized **Transmittal** for making contributions to **The Rotary Foundation** for your club members Sustaining Member contributions, **Name Badges** for events (including spouse badges), and **Mailing Labels**. In addition, there are Weekly Attendance functions to check-in live with a bar code scanner (or a mouse click), along with all the necessary reports at the member and club level, with automatic calculation of the Monthly Attendance values. Also, Weekly Attendance interfaces directly into the DUES/Invoicing module to generate "meal credits", when reporting Make-ups that qualify.

And, it **automatically** sends "the updates" to Rotary International's member database, thus eliminating multiple maintenance by the Club Secretary.

**Updating your information**

Initially, **as a Rotarian in this District, you may review and update your own record** for Personal & Contact Information. Here is how you do it: You have completed the sign-on procedure or you would not be reading this screen. [You signed on by using your E-mail address as the UserID, and your RI Member ID as your Password. (Your RI Member ID is on your monthly ROTARIAN magazine just above your Name, or you can get it from your club secretary). Just click VIEW My DATA (under the **MEMBER** tab), and then you may EDIT/change "your information", including the UserID and Password to values of your choice. This database is the central reservoir of district information, and whenever a change is made to club information or to a member's e-mail address, phone number, etc., that change is automatically reflected throughout in historical, club, and/or committee references. Once we have entered all the information about ourselves, this database will help in the following ways:

- Reviewing information about those who have served on committees in the past.
- Compiling names and addresses of current committee members.
- Sending **Personalized E-mails** to club and committees members
- Looking for special contacts, such as **Alumni** of The Rotary Foundation that live in our district (who are potential new Rotarians, so **ASK** them to join your club).

### ROTARY AND POLIO FACT SHEET

**Polio.** Poliomyelitis (polio) is a crippling and potentially fatal disease that still threatens children in parts of the world. The poliovirus invades the nervous system and can cause paralysis in a matter of hours. It can strike at any age but mainly affects children under five.

**Polio Today.** Today, there are only three countries that have never stopped transmission of the wild poliovirus: Afghanistan, Nigeria, and Pakistan. Fewer than 250 polio cases were reported worldwide in 2012, which is a 99% reduction since the 1960s, when the world saw about 1,000 cases per day. If we don't stay the course, experts say polio could rebound to 10 million cases in the next 40 years.

**Challenges.** The polio cases represented by the remaining one percent are the most difficult to prevent, due to factors including geographical isolation, poor public infrastructure, armed conflict and cultural barriers. Until polio is eradicated, all countries remain at risk of outbreaks.

**Ensuring Success.** Additional funding will help to end polio now. Thanks to a new campaign, every dollar donated to Rotary will be matched 2-to-1 by the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation. These funds help to provide much-needed operational support, medical personnel, laboratory equipment, and educational materials for health workers and parents. Governments, corporations and private individuals all play a crucial role in funding.

**PolioPlus.** Rotary launched its [PolioPlus](#) program, the first initiative to tackle global polio eradication, in 1985. Since then, Rotary and its partners have helped reduce the number of annual cases from 350,000 to fewer than 250 and remain committed until every child is safe from the disease. Rotary has contributed more than US\$1.2 billion and countless volunteer hours to protect more than 2 billion children in 122 countries. In addition, Rotary's advocacy efforts have played a role in decisions by donor governments to contribute over \$9 billion to the effort.

**Global Polio Eradication Initiative.** The [Global Polio Eradication Initiative](#), formed in 1988, is a public-private partnership including Rotary, the [World Health Organization](#), the [U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention](#), [UNICEF](#), the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation, and governments of the world. Rotary's focus is advocacy, fundraising, volunteer recruitment and awareness-building.

**Rotary in Action.** More than one million Rotary members have donated their time and personal resources to end polio. Every year, hundreds of Rotary members work side-by-side with health workers to vaccinate children in polio-affected countries. Rotarians work with partners like UNICEF to prepare and distribute mass communication tools to share the message with those isolated by conflict, geography, or poverty. Rotary members also recruit fellow volunteers, assist with transporting the vaccine, and provide other logistical support.

**'This Close' Campaign.** Rotary has a growing roster of public figures and celebrities participating in the "This Close" to ending polio public awareness campaign, including Bill Gates, Archbishop Desmond Tutu, Archa Panjabi, Jackie Chan, Jack Nicklaus and Pay. These ambassadors help educate the public about polio through public service announcements, social media and public appearances.

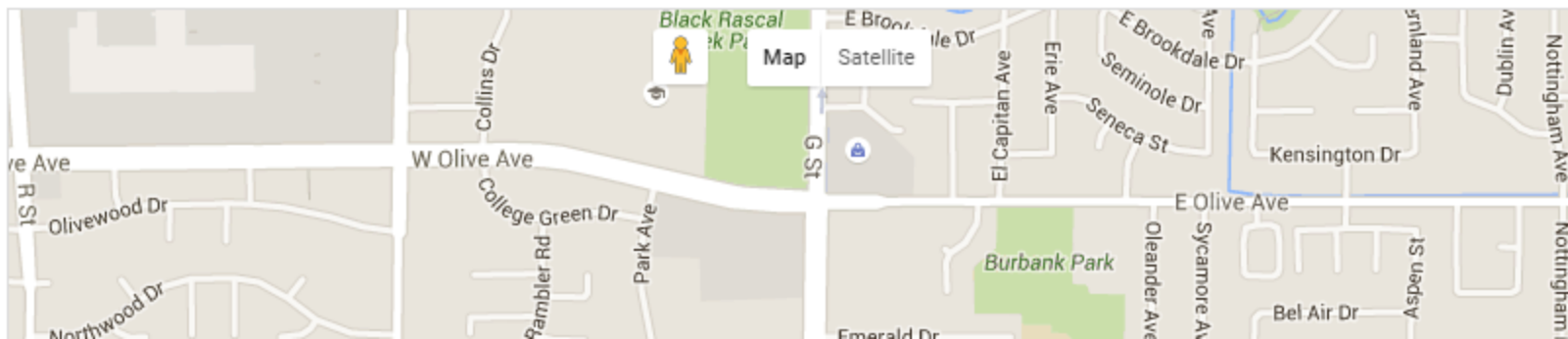

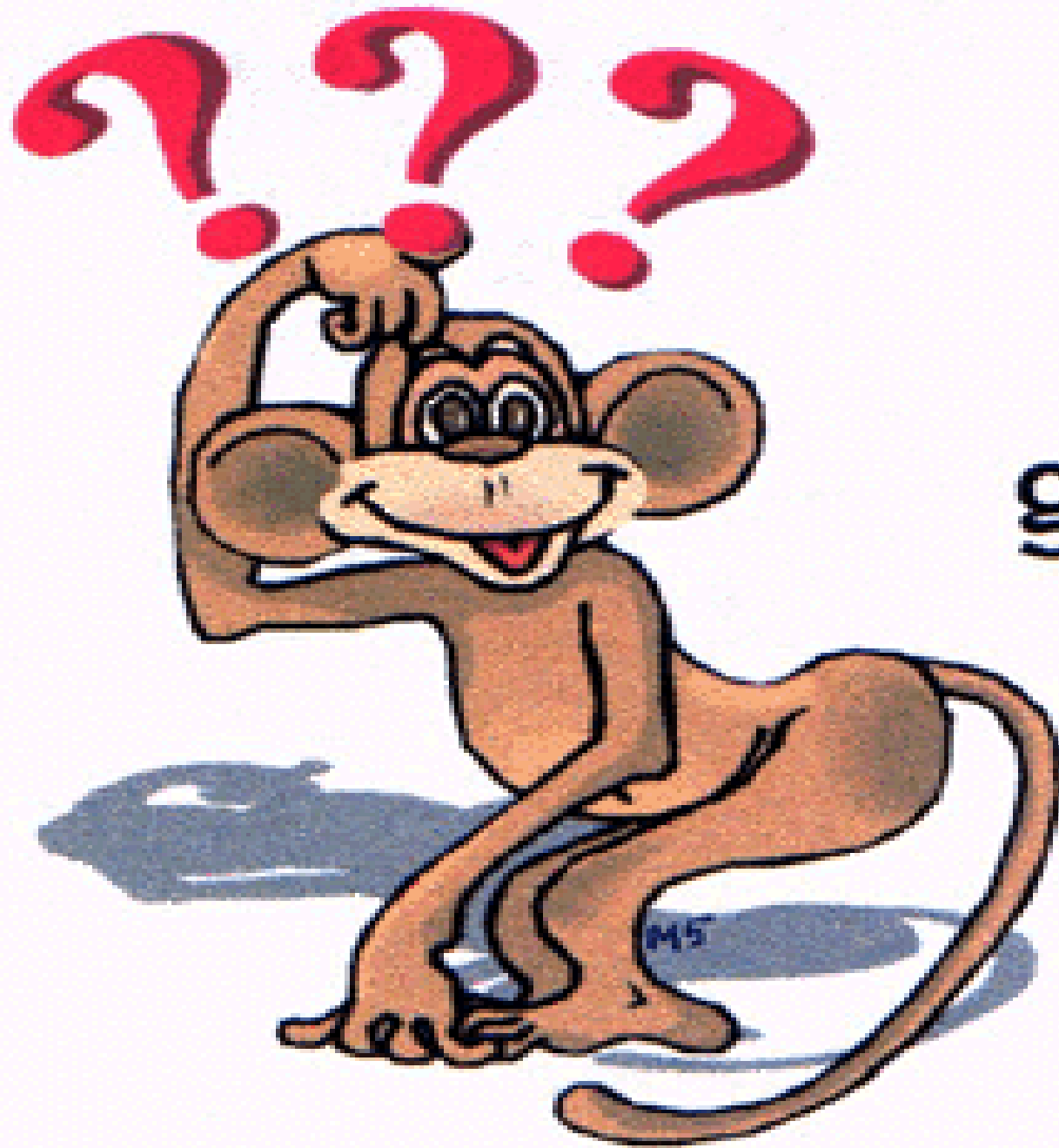
